

Brief Student Guide to Getting Started on CABWEB

Getting an Account

If this is your first time at CABWEB, you should create an account so that you can full access to the CABWEB facilities, including your collaboration space. If you click login, or try to access a network or collaboration space, you will be taken to the login screen where the instructions for creating an account are on the right hand side of the screen, see below.

Is this your first time here?

Hi! For full access to collaborations you'll need to take a minute to create a new account for yourself on this web site. Each of the individual collaborations may also have a one-time "enrolment key", which you won't need until later. Here are the steps:

1. Fill out the [New Account](#) form with your details.
2. An email will be immediately sent to your email address.
3. Read your email, and click on the web link it contains.
4. Your account will be confirmed and you will be logged in.
5. Now, select the collaboration you want to participate in.
6. If you are prompted for a "enrolment key" - use the one that your teacher has given you. This will "enrol" you in the collaboration.
7. You can now access the full collaboration. From now on you will only need to enter your personal username and password (in the form on this page) to log in and access any collaboration you have enrolled in.

Remember to bookmark <http://www.cabweb.net> so you can easily find your way back. In most cases, all should go smoothly but occasionally problems may arise. Here are some possible problems and solutions.

Problems	Solution
Account for that email address already exists on CABWEB portal	Click [Send my details by email] button and check for email (see next section)
You have accidentally mistyped your email address.	Try again
Unknown problem	Please send full details of ID, email address and when you tried to create the account to F.Bell@Salford.ac.uk , copied to your tutor. They should contact you within a couple of days.

Your Collaboration Space

Once you have an account, use the left hand side of the screen to log in.

If your tutor has opted for the enrolment key option, then you will need to obtain the key from your tutor, otherwise, you will be able to enrol yourself to the space.

How do I get into my collaboration space?

The easiest way is to look through the list of collaborations before you log in , and click yours if you recognise it. You will be invited to log in, and if it is your first time visiting the collaboration space, just check that it is the correct space, then say "Yes" to the invitation to enrol.

I am already logged in but I can't find my collaboration space.

If you start by logging in, you will be presented with your personal list of current collaborations. If you can't see the one you want, then click on[All collaborations].

I am enrolled in the wrong collaboration

From within that collaboration, look in the Administration Block (probably at the left of the screen) and unenrol yourself.
